Upton Warren Activity Week Visits 2017 (during the week of 10th-14th July)

We are offering Year Six pupils the opportunity to take part in a residential visit to Aztec Adventure Upton Warren. It will be a 2 day, 1 night residential trip.

Activities Week is split into two sections; one 3 day section (Mon-Wed), and one 2 day section (Thurs-Fri). Should your child be allocated a place in the 3 day section, they will spend the third day in school taking part in various fun activities. Your child will have to choose an optional activity for the other half of the week. These can be found in the Activity Week booklet that will be handed out shortly. There are options of free or charged activities.

At Upton Warren the children will take part in a range of water-based and land-based activities, including kayaking, climbing, archery, raft building and orienteering. All activities will be led by centre staff with national governing body or site-specific qualifications in the activities they instruct. There will also be members of our School staff present to supervise the children 24 hours a day. The overnight accommodation will be camping in 2 man tents, within the centres ground. Pupils will need to take their own sleeping bags, pillows, sleeping mats etc. The location itself is a secure site, close to Webbs of Wychbold.

The all-inclusive cost, covering instruction, 1 nights/2 days worth of activities, accommodation, food (1 breakfast, 2 lunches, 1 dinner), transport and insurance will be approximately £110.

We have been allocated a maximum of 72 places (36 each half). In the event of more than 72 pupils wishing to go, names will be placed in a hat and a draw will be made to allocate places. We reserve the right to refuse to take any pupils whose behaviour and attitude would, in our opinion, affect their own and others' safety.

If you would like your child to have a place on one of the courses, please complete the form attached and return it to me by Wednesday 18th January, together with a £30.00 deposit. Please make cheques payable to St Egwins CE Middle School. If we do have to draw names from a hat and your child is unlucky then the deposit will be refunded. If your child is given a place and then cannot go for any reason not normally covered by insurance, the deposit will only be refunded if the place can be filled.

Pupils may not swap to another Activities Week trip once the deposit has been paid.
