Dear Parents and Carers

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself. My name is Mr Jordan and I am the Head of Year 6.

Firstly, a huge welcome to St. Egwin's. We hope your child will be happy and successful during their time with us. It is incredible seeing how far pupils go in what is a very quick three years.

This year, transition will potentially be very different from previous years. Normally, the team from St. Egwin's will visit your child in their First School and talk in-depth to their Year 5 teacher and other connected staff. This is followed by the Transition Day in early July and meeting will parents and carers the same week. As I am sure you can appreciate, with us not knowing the Government's strategy at the time of writing, we are having to treat this transition in a slightly different manner.

In the coming weeks, myself, the Special Educational Need and Disability Coordinator and Safe Guarding Team will get in touch with your child's school and speak to them in-depth about your child and share information. Depending on the guidelines provided by the Government, we may be allowed to host small groups of Y5 pupils in school in the summer for a short period of time, or, produce a video that introduces the pupils to key staff and rooms around the school. We will aim to work on normal timelines for transition so expect to hear more in June and July but we are planning for this to be disrupted, unfortunately.

Included in this pack you will find the Admission Forms, Data Consent sheet, Food tech letter for contribution and pupil Questionnaire. Please return these to school (by post is preferable) as soon as possible.

Please be aware however, that we are operating on a rota and that answers to your queries may not be possible immediately.
